ROWING & SAILING LONGBOATS

Our longboats are historic replicas of the boats used by Captain George Vancouver and Peter Puget to explore and chart the waters of Puget Sound. Locally built, Townshend and Bear are 26 ft long, have 8 rowing stations and 3 sails. USCG inspected, the longboats are great platforms for developing maritime and life skills, community building and recreational charters. Experiences range from 2-3 hours to multi-day excursions.
