### Longboat Excursions

Discover rowing, sailing, navigating and leadership on a historic replica longboat. Traditional and contemporary maritime skills are developed while working as a team in exploring the beautiful waters of Puget Sound. Discover maritime life, from shipyards to remote beaches.

### What is a Longboat?

Captain George Vancouver and his Lt. Peter Puget used longboats to explore and chart the waterways of Puget Sound and northward. Their shallow draft allowed them to explore the shallow bays and inlets of the region. Our longboats are replicas of Vancouver's boats. Constructed of wood by local shipwrights, the boats are 26 feet long, and carry 8 oars and 3 sails. All gear is stored aboard. Groups sleep aboard and camp ashore.

Our vessels are inspected and licensed by the U.S. Coast Guard. Our licensed captain-instructor and mate will lead you on a discovery of maritime life.

Minimum participant age: 12 years
